

SEEING STARS - BLOCK 8

Star of Hope

This is a 20" (20-1/2") block created using templates. No math or fancy rulers are needed.

Note: Choose the same background fabric for your entire quilt. You will need approximately 6 yards of background fabric.

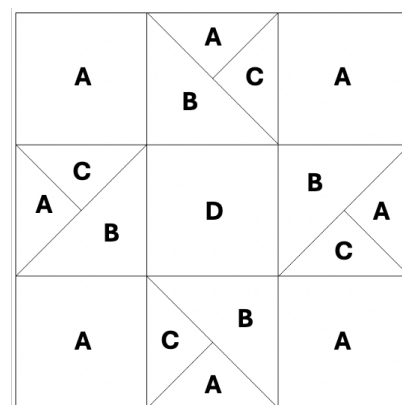
Fabrics / Quantity

Fabric A (Background): 8" x WOF

Fabric B (Star Points): 8" x 16"

Fabric C (Star Points): 8" Square

Fabric D (Center Square): 7-1/2" square



Cutting Instructions

Before cutting the fabrics, press them using Best Press or a similar product to stabilize the fabric and make it easier to work with.

Fabric A: Cut [4] 7 1/8" squares and [1] 7-7/8" square.

- Subcut the 7-7/8" square diagonally, corner to corner, in both directions. You will have [4] Fabric A triangles.

Fabric B: Cut [2] 7-1/2" squares.

- Subcut both squares diagonally, corner to corner, in one direction. You will have [4] Fabric B triangles.

Fabric C: Cut [1] 7-7/8" square.

- Subcut the 7-7/8" square diagonally, corner to corner, in both directions. You will have [4] Fabric C triangles.

Fabric D: Cut [1] 7-1/8" square.

Block Assembly

Step 1: Arrange and sew pieces A and C. Make [4]. Press.

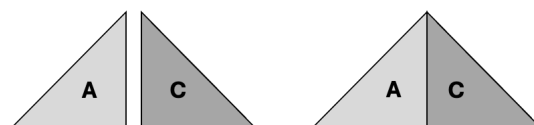

Step 2: Arrange and sew piece B to the A/C units you created in Step 1. Make [4]. Press. These units should measure 7-1/8" square.
